In Corozal, our town, it is easy to see what this verse describes. Of course, it is not Jesus who appears, but those who serve the Lord following the mission to serve our neighbors. This place needs God's love. This place needs the gospel. Short-term mission teams and medical teams sent by different countries often come to preach the gospel, treat diseases. Local pastors are devoted to taking care of the people. Most church congregations are unable to donate money, so pastors both young and old have to work full-time jobs and then come to church to serve during weekends. Our supporters are also participating in the ministry of this place through intercession and donation.

We have noticed many young people in Corozal are unemployed, depressed, and struggling to support their families. They are navigating challenges like marriage breakdown, children being hungry and dropping out of school, and loss of hope in the community. We feel compelled to respond—not just by giving charitably, but through other ways to help people transform their lives.

Our mission

Two years ago, we thought of a Life Change Project, a faith-based, farm-operated residential training center. Participants will engage in a training course lasting 2 to 3 years:

- Agricultural production
- Vocational skills: Automotive repair, welding, carpentry, plumbing
- Administration and Media: Bookkeeping, Computer Skills, Media Operations
- Spiritual Mentorship: Daily spirituality, life coaching, family values education

This program can only accept young adult men at this time. The center will provide free meals, accommodation and allowances to create a stable and caring environment. Through living and working together, participants will not only learn employable skills but will also be shaped in character, responsibility and faith. The goal is to support them to make meaningful contributions to the social and economic development of Belize. This is not just about training, but about making an “impact” in communities, families and individuals.

Currently needed

- Land required for farm operations center (minimum 20 acres)
- Financial support for infrastructure, equipment and operating expenses
- Build partnerships with government agencies, churches and donors who share a common vision

Latest situation

In October 2025, we were donated a conditional land proposal for 18.41 acres in the community of Chunox in the Corozal district. The land provides us with the perfect opportunity to establish a center for nurturing young adulthood.

To steward this opportunity well, we’re seeking to raise funds in phases, with a matching approach tied to land access:

- Phase 1 (1st 6 months): \$150,000 USD → unlocks the first 3 acres
- Phase 2 (2nd 6 months): \$150,000 USD → unlocks the second 3 acres
- Phase 3 (2nd year): \$100,000 USD → unlocks the third 4 acres

The development program will begin with housing facilities for construction employees and trainees, work sheds, planting fields, greenhouses, driveways and other infrastructure. We hope to start fundraising in January 2026 and are waiting for God’s leading timing and provision.
