God has given us many surprises and good things in January, it brings us joy to walk into 2026!

In mid-January Gregory returned to Belize, our second home. Upon arrival he called our landlord, only to learn that the landlord's wife had suffered a fall. The couple had moved to another city to live with their daughter and are not expected to return until March. They were in the rush and forgot to inform us. As a result, Gregory had to immediately search for a place to stay. Thanks be to God, the chiropractors to whom we often bring friends for treatment have become friends over the years. Just a month ago they expanded their clinic, completed renovations, and added a residential floor upstairs. There was a room available for us to rent. After moving in, our spirits lifted—the room is comfortable, and Gregory can also enjoy the living room, dining table, and kitchen. The greatest joy is sharing the same building with the doctors' families, occasionally dining together and conversing. This warmth of home is truly the greatest gift to missionaries.

We also met a new friend. He lives very simply on a low income yet regularly opens his house to strangers who have no place to live. His love and generosity deeply moved us and encouraged our mission to build a dormitory center. He introduced us to visit an agricultural high school not far from the land where we plan to build the farm and dormitory. Gregory met with the vice principal to explore possible cooperation. The vice principal strongly affirmed our plan and said their graduates could receive on-the-job training at the farm. This is truly exciting news.



At the end of January, four pastors from California came to visit the ministry site. They are the advisor team of Maker Impact Center (MIC). This time they came specifically to inspect the donated 18-acres land, and also toured the towns of Corozal and Chunox to assess the potential for ministry development in the

surrounding areas. This is undoubtedly thrilling, as if the pieces of a puzzle are falling into place, soon to form a complete picture.

Thank you for your partnership and traveling our mission journey with us. Challenges are part of life but God is good. We are thankful we have settled into a church in California. We participate in their worship services, prayer meetings, small groups, and holiday outreach activities. Gregory occasionally preaches there. Though it is a small church, it has a great passion for evangelism and is actively engaged in local gospel work and overseas missions. They also support our missionary work, which greatly encourages us. We thank God for giving us this spiritual home.
